In order to ensure that this fund is endowed, we must raise a minimum of \$100,000. We are hopeful that we will exceed this minimum threshold, as additional support will enable us to make a greater impact when awarding grants.

Guided by Doug's principles and priorities, the fund will provide resources for staff recognition and employee support, such as professional development and continuing education, as we continue to strive to be the best place to give care and to get care in Wake County. Grants and awards from the fund will be made at the discretion of Duke Raleigh leadership and staff.

All those who know Doug and have been influenced by his work at Duke Raleigh are asked to consider making a donation to the Doug Vinsel Endowment Fund. This includes physicians, staff, current and former advisory board members, grateful patients, and all other friends and supporters of Duke Raleigh.

Gifts to the Doug Vinsel Endowment Fund are tax deductible at the highest limits for federal income and estate tax purposes, as Duke University is a qualified charitable organization under Internal Revenue Section Code 501(c)(3).

There are a variety of ways in which donors can make gifts, the most common of which are by writing a check or transferring securities. Pledges may be paid over a period of up to five years.
